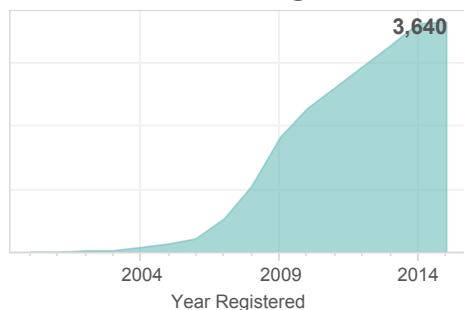

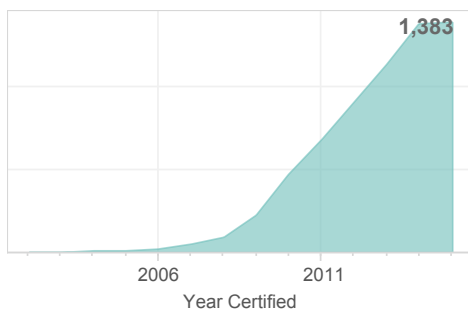

## Cumulative LEED® Registrations



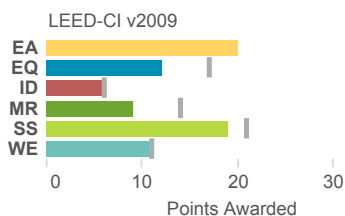
## Cumulative LEED® Certifications



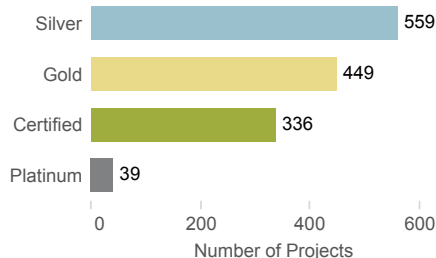

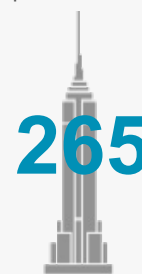

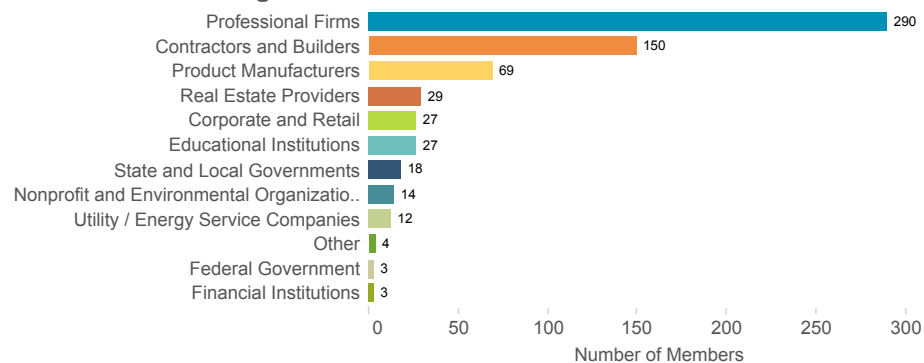
